

## **IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION**

## **WORK AREA**

- Keep the work area clean and well lit. Cluttered and dark areas invite accidents.
- Do not operate power tools in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases or dust. Power tools create sparks, which may ignite the dust or fumes.
- Keep children or unauthorized individuals away from the work area, while working with power tools. Distractions can cause you to lose control.

## **ELECTRICAL SAFETY**

• Do not store or use power tools in wet conditions (rain, snow). Water entering a power tool will increase the risk of electric shock.

## **ADDITIONAL SAFETY WARNINGS FOR BRUSH CUTTERS**

- Avoid Unintentional Starting. Do not carry battery-installed equipment with finger on switch. Be sure switch is off when installing a battery cartridge.
- The motor is to be switched off immediately in case that the equipment shows any problem or abnormal sign.
- Switch off and remove the battery cartridge when resting and when leaving the equipment unattended, and place it in a safe location to prevent danger to others or damage to the equipment.
- Don't force the equipment. it will do the job better and with less likelihood of a risk of injury at the rate for which it was designed.
- Don't overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times.

## CHECK BEFORE STARTING

- Always remove the battery to prevent the machine being started by accident. Always disconnect the battery before any maintenance on the machine.
- Before using the machine and after any impact, check for signs of wear or damage and repair as necessary.
- Inspect the working area. Remove all loose objects, such as stones, broken glass, nails, steel wire, string, etc. that could be thrown out or become wrapped around the cutter or cutter guard.

### PERSONAL SAFETY

- The cutting tool does not stop immediately after the machine is turned off.
- The machine is only design for brush/trimmer. Do not use the Brush cutter/grass trimmer for any job except that for which it is intended.
- Store the equipment in a lockable area so that it is out of reach of children and unauthorized persons.
- Keep hands and feet away from the cutting area at all times and especially when switching on the motor.

## POWER TOOL USE AND CARE

- Only use original spare parts.
- Always ensure that ventilation openings are kept clear of debris.
- All covers, guards and handles must be fitted before starting.
- Only use the machine in daylight or in other well-lit conditions.
- Never use the machine in bad weather, for instance in fog, in rain, damp or in wet locations, strong winds, intense cold, risk of lightning, etc. Extremely hot weather may cause overheating of the machine



# INSTALLING AND REMOVING THE BATTERY PACK FROM THE APPLIANCE

WARNING!



Make certain the lock-off Make certain the lock-off button is not engaged to prevent switch actuation before removing or installing battery.

## TO INSTALL BATTERY PACK

Insert battery into appliance until an audible click is heard. Ensure battery pack is fully seated and fully latched into position.

## TO REMOVE BATTERY PACK

Depress the battery release button and pull battery pack out of appliance.



WARNING!



Before assembly make sure that the appliance is switched off and the battery has been removed. Assembly tools required (not supplied).

## INSTALLING THE GUARD

- Using a screwdriver, insert the guard screw and tighten securely as shown in (Fig. 1) to complete the guard assembly.
- Once the guard is installed, remove the covering from the line cutoff blade, located on the edge of the guard.
- Push the handle completely onto the housing and position it slightly until it "snaps" into place.

## **HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT**

- To adjust the handle up or down, press in on the button (A) and raise or lower the handle (Fig. 2).
- The handle should be adjusted so that your front arm is straight when the trimmer is in the working position.

Adjust the length of the trimmer to obtain proper working positions shown in (Fig. 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D).





- The overall height of the trimmer can be adjusted by loosening the heightadjust collar (A) by rotating it in the direction of the arrow shown in (Fig. 4).

## RELEASING THE CUTTING LINE

In transit, the cutting line is taped to the spool housing.

Remove the tape holding the cutting line to the spool housing.

IMPORTANT!



Inspect area to be trimmed and remove any wire, cord, or string-like objects which could become entangled in the rotating line or spool. Be particularly careful to avoid any wire which might be bent outwardly into the path of the appliance, such as barbs at the base of a chain link fence.

## OPERATING THE TRIMMER

- To switch the appliance on, push the lock-off button, and squeeze the trigger.
- To switch the appliance off, release the trigger.
- With the unit on, angle unit and slowly swing the trimmer side to side as shown in (Fig. 3A).
- Maintain a cutting angle of 5° to 10° as shown in (Fig. 3B). Do not exceed 10° (Fig. 3C). Cut with the tip of the line. To keep distance from hard surfaces use edge wheel.
- To avoid damaging cultivated plants while trimming, use the retractable limiting bracket.
- Maintain a minimum distance of 60 cm between the guard and your feet as shown in (Fig. 3D). To achieve this distance adjust the overall height of the trimmer as shown in (Fig. 4).

## CONVERT TO EDGING MODE




IMPORTANT



The wheeled edge guide should only be used when in the edging mode. The trimmer can be used in trimming mode or edging mode to trim overhanging grass along lawn edges and flower beds.

For edging, the trimmer head should be in the vertical position shown in (Fig. 5). If it is not:

- Remove the battery from the trimmer.
- Grasp the flip-to-edge collar and push down as shown in fig. 8).
- Rotate the flip-to-edge collar 90° clockwise as shown in fig. 8, until the handle locks



## **FDGING**



WARNING!



When being used as an edger, stones, pieces of metal and other objects can be thrown out at high speed by the line. The trimmer and guard are designed to reduce the danger. However, make sure that other persons and pets are at least 30 m away. Optimum cutting results are achieved on edges deeper than 50 mm.

- Do not use this trimmer to create trenches.
- Using the edging wheel, guide the trimmer as shown in (Fig. 5).
- Position the edging wheel on the edge of the sidewalk or abrasive surface so the cutting line is over the grass or dirt area to be edged.
- To make a closer cut, slightly tilt the trimmer.

## HELPFUL CUTTING TIPS

- Use the tip of the string to do the cutting; do not force string head into uncut grass. Use edge guide along such things as fences, houses and flower beds for best practices.
- Wire and picket fences cause extra string wear, even breakage. Stone and brick walls, curbs, and wood may wear string rapidly.
- Do not allow spool cap to drag on ground or other surfaces.
- In long growth cut from the top down and do not exceed 35 cm high.
- Keep trimmer tilted toward the area being cut; this is the best cutting area.
- The trimmer cuts when passing the unit from the right to left. This will avoid throwing debris at the
- Avoid trees and shrubs. Tree bark, wood moldings, siding, and fence posts can easily be damaged by the string.

## CUTTING LINE / LINE FEFDING

Your trimmer uses 1.8 mm diameter, round nylon line. During use, the tips of the nylon lines will become frayed and worn and the special self feeding spool will automatically feed and trim a fresh length of line. Cutting line will wear faster and require more feeding if the cutting or edging is done along sidewalks or other abrasive surfaces or heavier weeds are being cut. The advanced automatic line feeding mechanism senses when more cutting line is needed and feeds and trims the correct length of line whenever it's required. Do not bump unit on ground in attempt to feed line or for any other purposes.









Remove the battery from the trimmer before making any assembly, adjustments or changing accessories. Such preventive safety measures reduce the risk of starting the appliance accidentally. From time to time, especially when cutting thick or stalky weeds, the line feeding hub may become clogged with sap or other material and the line will become jammed as a result. To clear the jam, follow the steps listed below.

- Remove the battery from the trimmer.
- Press the release tabs (A) on the line spool cap (B), as shown in (Fig. 6) and remove the cap by pulling it straight off.
- Pull the nylon line spool out and clear any broken line or cutting debris from the spool area.
- Place spool and line into spool cap with line "parked" in slots provided as shown in (Fig. 7A).
- Insert the line end through the appropriate hole in the spool housing.
   Pull slack line through until it pulls out of the holding slots as shown in (Fig. 7B).












- Press the button to adjust the angle of the pole in (Fig. 8).
- The head can be adjusted directly by pushing hard (Fig. 9).
- The length of the rod can be adjusted after opening it, and it can be fixed by pressing it back (Fig. 10).
- Press the spool down GENTLY and rotate it until you feel it drop into place and then push to snap into place. (When in place, the spool will turn a few degrees left and right freely).
- Take care to keep the line from becoming trapped under the spool.
- Align the spool cap tabs with the slots on the spool housing.
- Snap the spool cap back on as shown in (Fig. 11) by depressing lugs and pressing into spool housing.





NOTE



Make sure that cover is fully positioned, listen for two audible clicks to ensure both lugs are correctly located. Power the appliance on. In a few seconds or less you'll hear the nylon line being cut automatically to the proper length.

## **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**

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- Regularly clean the ventilation slot in your tool using a soft brush or dry cloth.
- Regularly clean the cutting line and spool using a soft brush or dry cloth.
- Regularly use a blunt scraper to remove grass and dirt from the underneath of the guard.
